Regulations XVII, Academic Year 2024-2025 and 2025-2026

Students' Code of Behaviour

Students are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that does not impair or disturb in any way the academic environment of the classroom/online classes or the institution or bring the Lahore School of Economics into disrepute by their actions or word of mouth.

Any of the actions listed below may result in disciplinary action leading to a written reprimand; fine; putting on probation; cancellation of paper, reductions in grade, 'I' or 'F' grade (if found cheating in examinations); suspension from a semester by cancellation of registration for a semester with fees forfeited; suspension for a year and permanent separation from the Lahore School.

1. Knowingly providing false information to the Lahore School.
2. Being involved in forgery, alteration, misuse of schools documents or instruments or student identification cards with intent to deceive.
3. Misbehaving on campus or in online classes with a teacher or staff member or a designated invigilator for Lahore School examinations on or outside the campus.
4. Intentionally disrupting, obstructing teaching, research, administration, or any other institutional activities of the Lahore School.
5. Disturbing the school environment by making noise, playing music outside the classrooms, indulging in disruptive behaviour in the classrooms or online classes, facilities, compound or parking lots of the school.
6. Failing to comply with instructions of duly authorized and identified college staff (including security staff).
7. Being involved in theft of equipment, stationery, books, or furnishings of the school.
8. Willful damage to property of Lahore School or that of the faculty, or staff.
9. Unbecoming or rowdy behavior or use of uncouth language on campus, harassment, fighting, smoking, carrying or use of drugs or arms or articles capable of causing bodily damage, wearing on campus excessively informal clothing including clothes with imprinted words or pictures, T-shirts without collars and/or sleeves, shirts without sleeves, shorts and tights.
10. Bringing the school, its faculty and its staff into disrepute by word of mouth, in writing (including online) or through use of derogatory language in written applications, reports, exam papers, presentations or newspaper articles.
11. Cheating in Lahore School examinations and quizzes. Students should not have mobile phones in their possession during an ongoing mid semester exam and final exam and quizzes.
12. Mobile/ Cell Phones: Using of cell phones is prohibited during classes. Any violation of this rule may be referred to the Disciplinary and Unfair Means Cases Committee and in the case of a mobile phone or any other electronic device found on a student during an examination considered as cheating in examinations.
13. Plagiarism in reports, research papers, presentations or theses/research projects completed in programmes taken at the Lahore School and in articles published while studying at the Lahore School and will be referred to the Plagiarism Standing Committee.
14. The Student Code of Behaviour will be implemented through the Disciplinary and Unfair Means Cases Committee or the Harassment Inquiry Committee.
