ACADEMIC RESEARCH PAPERS

In my paper, "THE EFFECT OF SCREENING PEER MONITORING, GROUP PRESSURE AND SOCIAL TIES ON MICROFINANCE BORROWING GROUPS' REPAYMENT BEHAVIOR", we conducted a survey of 225 urban borrowing groups at Akhuwat (interest free microfinance bank) in Lahore, Pakistan. We looked at the effects of screening, monitoring, group pressure and social ties on borrowing groups' repayment behavior measured by delinquency. From the paper, we have found out that social ties positively effects delinquency while group pressure reduces delinquency. While female groups are less delinquent than males.
