I am an educationist, linguist, writer and academic leader whose work connects scholarship, creativity, and social engagement. I earned my Ph.D. in Applied Linguistics from the University of Toronto, Canada, my M.Ed. in TESOL from the University of Manchester, UK, and completed my post-doctoral research at the University of Oxford, UK.

With over four decades of experience in teaching, research, and academic leadership, I have served in several leading universities including the Lahore University of Management Sciences (LUMS), The Aga Khan University (AKU), Ghulam Ishaq Khan Institute (GIKI), National University of Modern Languages (NUML), and the Lahore School of Economics (LSE), where I am currently serving as Dean, Faculty of Social Sciences, Media Studies, Art and Design. Earlier, I had the privilege of serving as Vice Chancellor of Allama Iqbal Open University (AIOU) from 2014 to 2018.

I have authored more than fifteen books, including *Education Policies in Pakistan: Politics, Projections, and Practices* and *Language, Gender, and Power: The Politics of Representation and Hegemony in South Asia*, both published by Oxford University Press. My earlier books include *Rethinking Education in Pakistan: Perceptions, Practices, and Possibilities* and *Education, Inequalities, Freedom: A Sociopolitical Critique*. And *Reimagining Education in Pakistan: Politics, Projections, and Practices*.

In addition to academic work, I write creatively. My books, such as *Aasman Dar Aasman* and *Pothohar: Khitta-e-Dilruba* explore themes of memory, migration, and identity. I also serve as the Editor of the weekly online newsletter “*Education and Culture in South Asia*”, which presents critical reflections on education, culture, and society in the region.

Research Projects

Cognitive Consequences of Exposure to print

This was the topic of my Ph.D. research which I undertook in University of Toronto, Canada. The study sought to examine the cognitive effects of exposure to print within a literate society. It attempted to extend the already existing research by focusing on additional consequences of literacy activities, namely, the ability to make subtle

vocabulary distinctions and to engage in decontextualized reasoning. Thus this study contributed a theoretical understanding of the role of print exposure.

Teaching of Reading Skills to Intermediate Level Students in Pakistan

This was the topic of my research thesis in M.Ed. TESOL in university of Manchester. The thesis aimed at exploring the problems faced by Pakistani students at Intermediate level in reading and suggesting a more balanced syllabus to develop language skills, and an effective teaching strategy to develop reading skills among students.

Orthography and reading proficiency project

I worked on this project with Dr. Linda Siegel, University of Toronto, Canada. My job on this project involved studying the interrelationship of orthography and reading proficiency. For this purpose, I developed a number of tasks for Urdu language (written from right to left). Some of the tasks I developed / adapted for the project included working memory task, visual condition task, oral close task, WRAT, word identification task, word attack task, and orthographic task.

Talk to learn project

On this project I worked closely with Dr. Gordon Wells University of Toronto, Canada. My job on this project was to code, and analyses the classroom interaction from audio and video tapes. This involved the use of discourse coding capturing the fine details of intended meaning of the discourse by describing the actual movements, facial expressions, and contextual background etc.

Outcomes of Exposure to Print

On this project I worked with Dr. Keith Stanovich, University of Toronto, Canada. The project required me to design and develop print exposure measures, Also I was involved in entering, and analysing the data using certain statistical packages.

A study of managing Community Participation and Empowerment for Improving Pre-Primary and Primary Education in Rural and urban Areas of Sindh

The focus of this study was to understand the dynamics of community participation that may help empower the community in managing schools effectively a research study was planned to understand the processes and strategies involved in managing the community for sustainable partnership and look at the nature of the working relationship between stakeholders and also compare and contrast the achievements of the project schools within an across the urban (initiated by AKES, P in Karachi) and rural settings.

A study of Multi grade teaching in Rural and Urban Areas of Sindh

I was a part of this study that was designed to examine the current practices of multi grade teaching in primary schools of rural and urban areas of Sind, i.e., what are the current methods which are used by the teachers, what are the different problems faced by the teachers in teaching in such situation etc.

Working with Primary School Teachers in Baluchistan: A case Study of Mentoring Practices and Processes

I had been a part of this study that was designed around a primary teacher mentoring programme in Blochistan which was organized by IED, the Aga Khan university to train mentor teachers who could then train the primary teachers to ensure improvement in quality of teaching at the grass roots level. The study intended to understand the process of mentoring and mentor work in clusters; observe its effect at grass roots level in the rural primary schools; identify the challenges in the programme; set up support mechanism to meet the challenges; and track the influence of support.

I was a part of the two-member committee of Asia Foundation and University Grants Commission; the other member on the committee was Prof. David Eskey from USC.
