## LAHORE SCHOOL YOUNG PEACE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPS

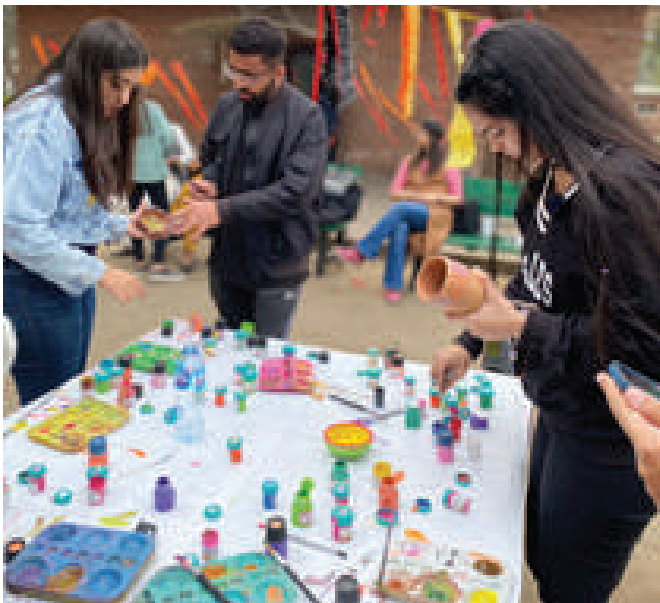
### ORIENTATION

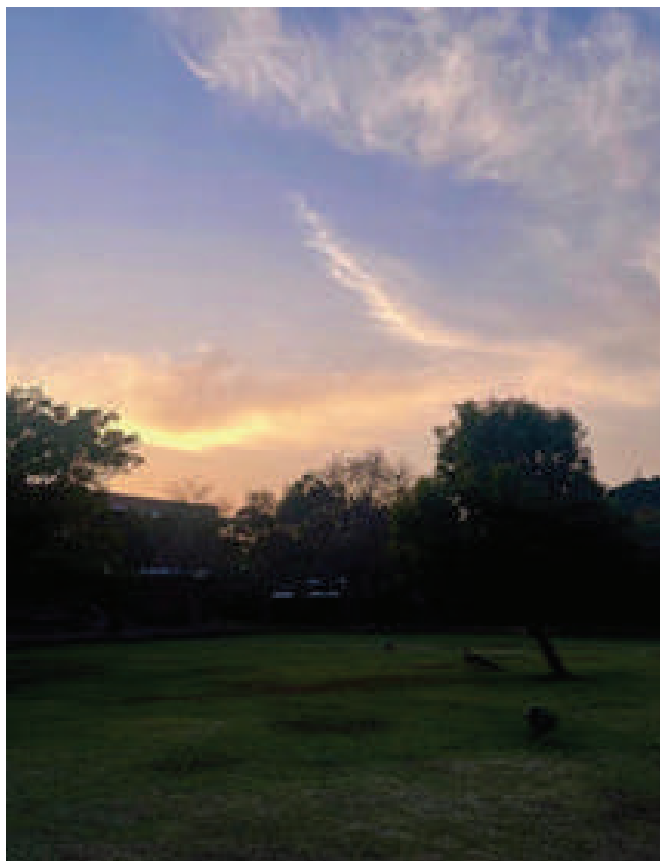
## COLLABORATION IN SME WITH AANDHI (SECTION A) FOR E-WASTE COLLECTION DRIVE

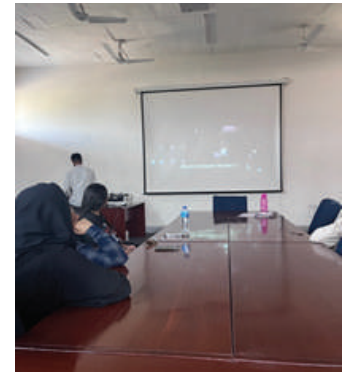
## ACTING WORKSHOP BY YASSAR KHAN

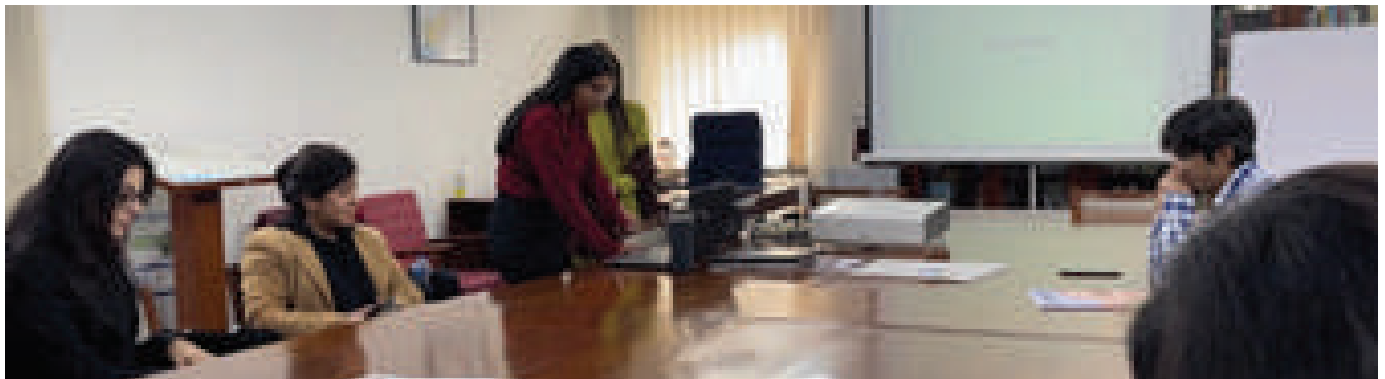
## MOVIE SCREENING

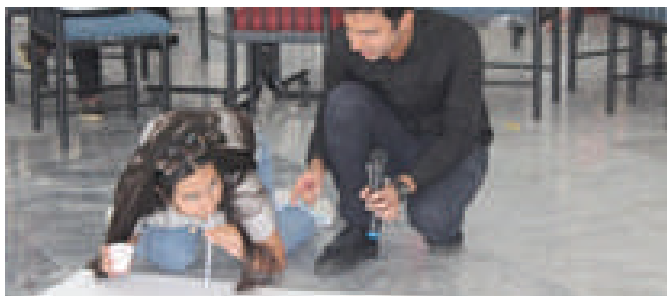
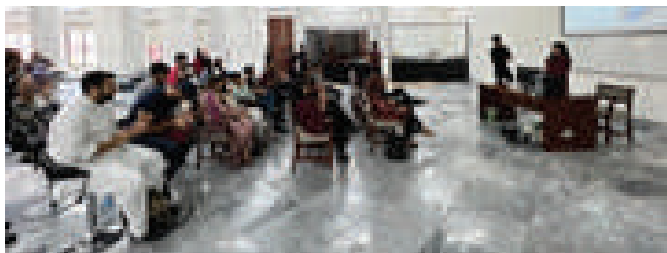




## LAHORE SCHOOL ARTS SOCIETY

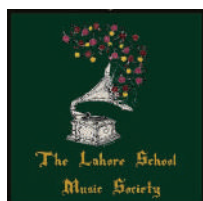

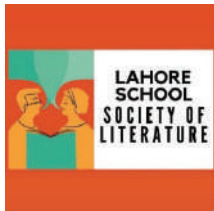

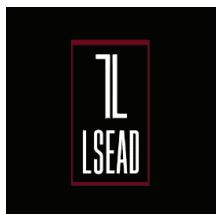
