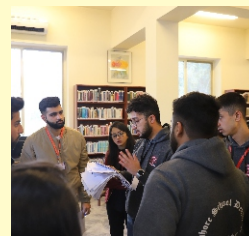

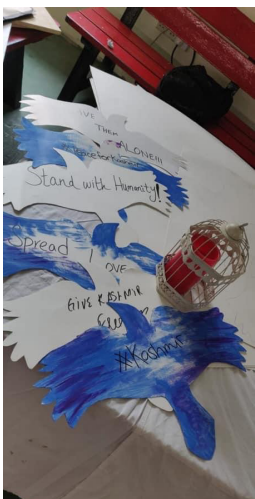
ORIENTATION

Lahore School Arts Society celebrated Spring Festival outside H4 on February 12, 2020.

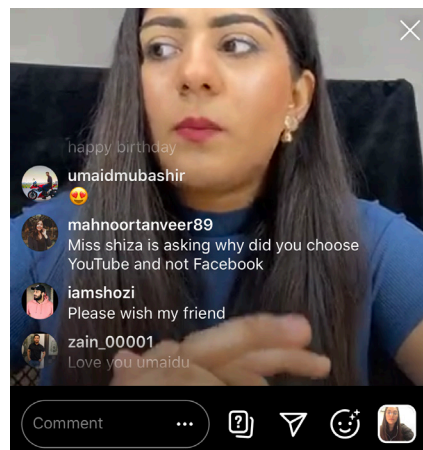
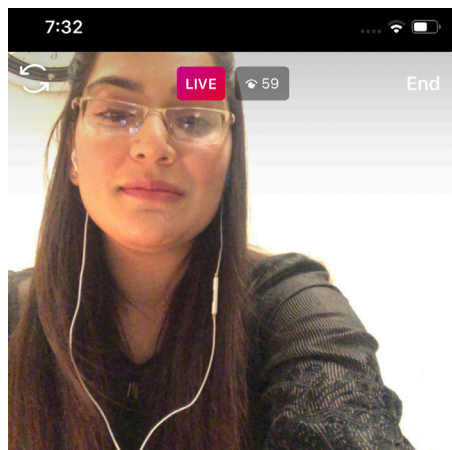


MOLDING AND CASTING WORKSHOP

Debating Society participated in UCL “Shahjiwana International Debating Championship 2020”. Overall 3 teams from Lahore School of Economics participated in the English category.



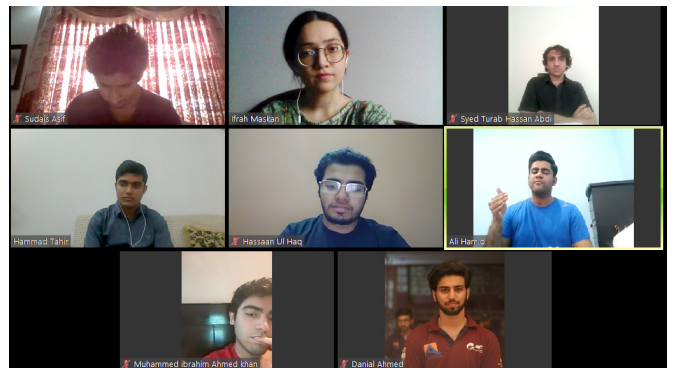
LUMS INTER VARSITY - ENGLISH DEBATING TOURNAMENT

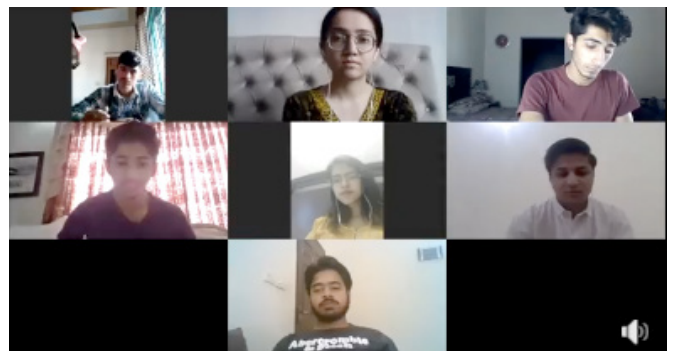
LAHORE GRAMMAR SCHOOL DECLAMATION COMPETITION



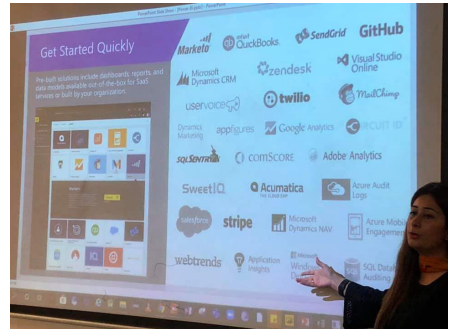

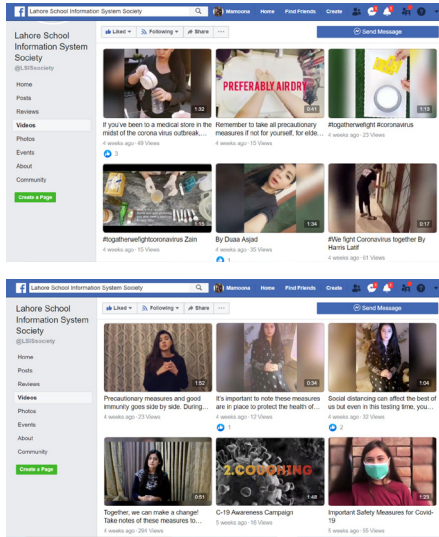
GO GREEN CAMPAIGN BY LSISS

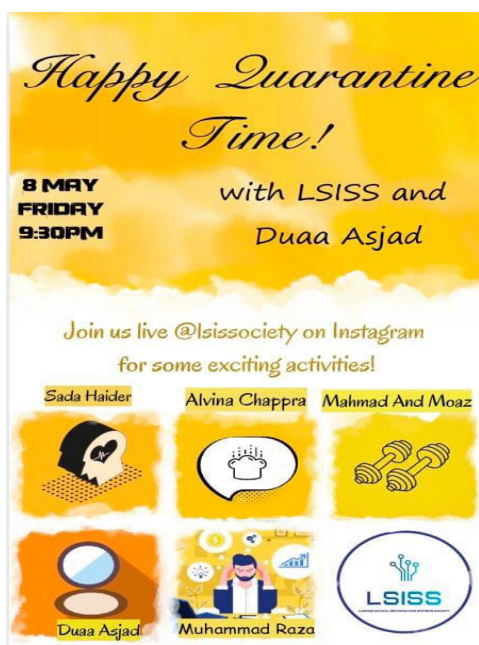

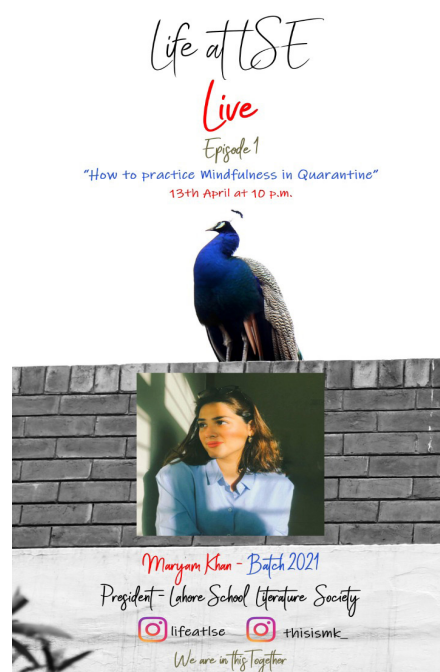


JOURNALS BY THE LAHORE SCHOOL SOCIETY OF LITERATURE

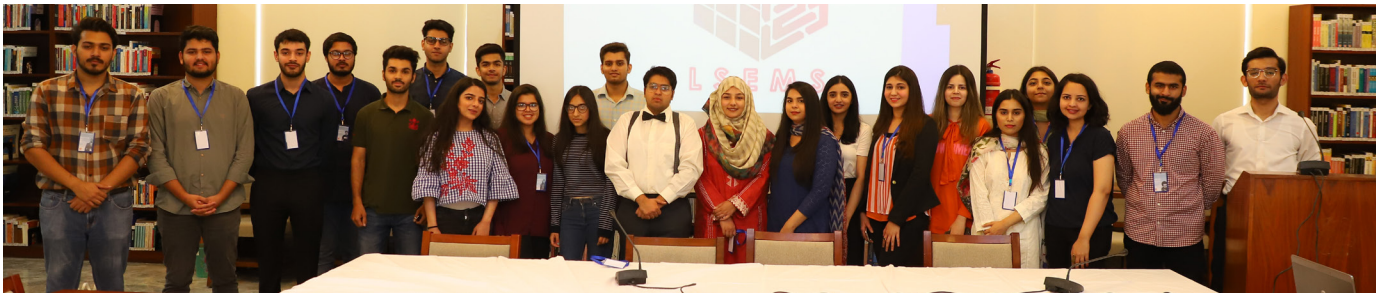

MIRA HASHMI'S WORKSHOP

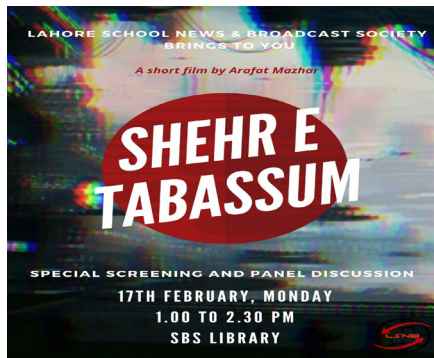
On February 11, 2019, The Lahore School News & Broadcast Society organized a workshop, led by one of our well-spoken faculty members, Mira Hashmi.

TRIP TO ROHTAS FORT

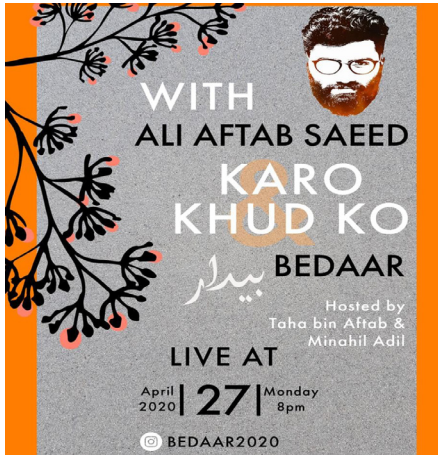

A few things that were taught in the workshop included:

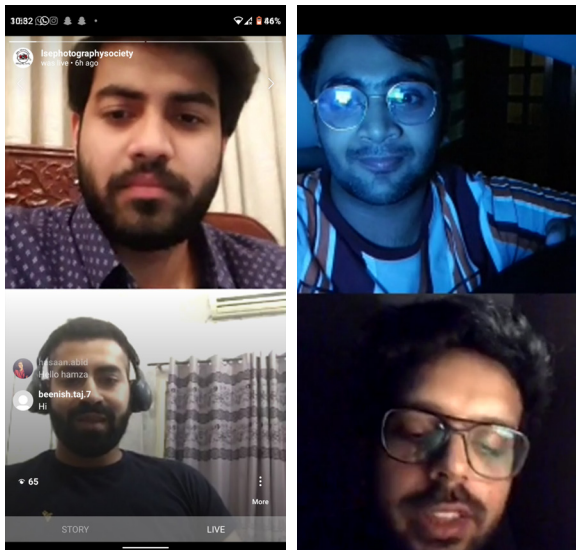

The Lahore School Youth Peace & Development Corps celebrated Iqbal Day on November 14,

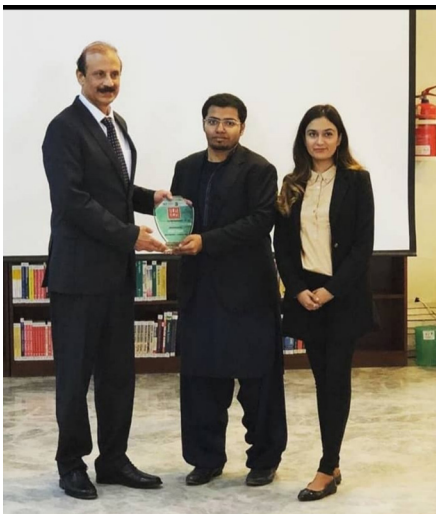
STRESS-LESS LSE

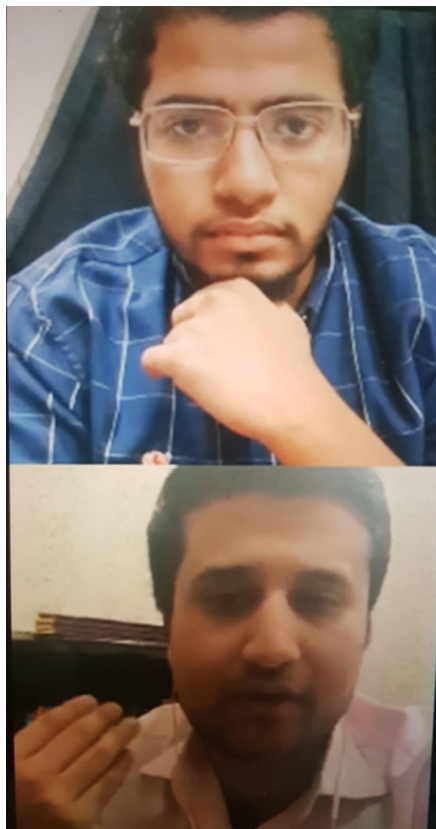
LSYPDC POLICY MAKING COMPETITION 2020

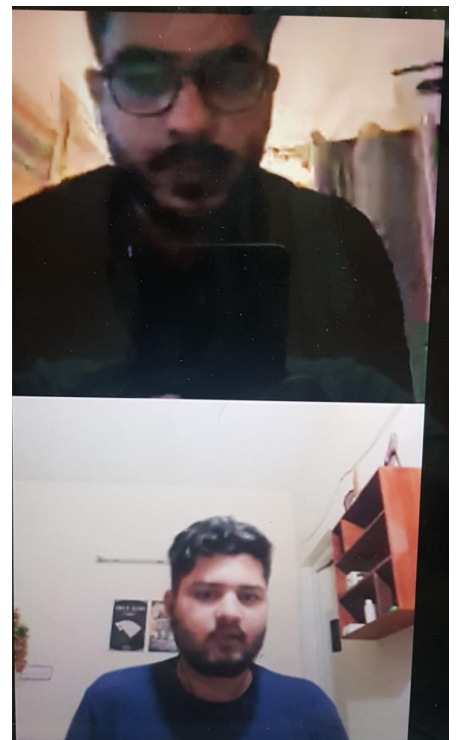
“A DAY IN QUARANTINED LIFE, IN PICTURES”
